Information & Photographs Needed:

If you are looking to sell/buy a particular type of hot rod, custom, classic or muscle car please send the following complete information and photographs (digital required) to dburdge@dreamrodlocator.com:

PHOTOS needed: [Send more photos rather than less!]

- Direct in front (right, left, center)
- Direct in rear (right, left, center)
- Side view (both sides)
- Front side view from $\frac{3}{4}$ angle (both sides)
- Rear side view from $\frac{3}{4}$ angle (both sides)
- Engine view (at least 10 shots top & bottom, try to let viewer see everything)
- Interior view (dash, under-dash, door panels front/back, all floor boards, front seat, rear area, headliner, trunk)
- The entire undercarriage (at least 20 shots of both sides front to rear, transmission/engine/drivetrain/rearend, header/muffler system, etc.)
- If your car is an unfinished car and currently apart please be sure to photograph **all** the parts.

Additional INFORMATION needed: [The more info you send the better ad-article we can write.]

- Any details about the car's build history are VITAL if available? Such as,
- How many owners? Who was the original owner, etc.? (Names and dates if possible)
- Is it the original steel car or a fiberglass replica? (Include documentation)
- If it is a replica of a famous car? Who built it?
- Is it a show car (when/where)? List trophies.
- Where has it been stored and for how long?
- How often is it driven? How far is your longest trip? What is current mileage?
- What kind of chassis?
- When was the car painted? Date _____ by whom? _____
- Describe engine in full detail? When was the engine built? How many miles are on the engine? (...if dates on transmission build are different, list separately.)
 1. Racing components in/on engine?
 2. Induction system: 4 barrel or 2 barrel carburetor, injection or blower, etc.?
 3. Identify type of exhaust and/or header system?
 4. Transmission type, drive line & rear end type and gear ratio?
 5. Specify chrome or other extras?

- What is the **condition of the steel** (or fiberglass) body? Please list ALL rust or damage and the location, Bondo work, etc. (Full-disclosure helps international/national buyers to determine the integrity of the car—very important.)
- List any **items that have been changed** from the original car? This is especially important for classic and numbers matching factory produced cars, for buyers, collectors and museum owners who will demand this type of information.
- **Chassis** builder and details regarding its construction?
- **Painter(s)**? If a race car, what signage was originally on the car? Has it been reproduced accurately?
- What type of **ownership papers** do you have? Does it have a bill of sale? Is it actually titled, what state? Does it have current registration?

Provide copies of any authentication such as:

- Original photographs, newspaper or magazine write ups, TV coverage on video/DVD
- Published documentation in books
- Any/all information you have access to that will verify the car is **original steel**
- Any/all information you have access to that will verify it is an **authentic replication** made by the original builder
